What is RTO Tiruppur (TN39)?

RTO Tiruppur **TN39** is the Regional Transport Office responsible for implementing the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act in Tiruppur district, Tamil Nadu. It functions under the Tamil Nadu Transport Department and regulates vehicle registration, driving licences, permits, tax collection, and road safety compliance.

The office ensures that every vehicle operating within its jurisdiction complies with government regulations. It also promotes road safety by issuing licences only to eligible drivers and conducting inspections of commercial and transport vehicles.

Services Offered by RTO Tiruppur (TN39)

The Regional Transport Office provides numerous transport-related services for individuals and commercial vehicle owners.

1. Vehicle Registration

Maintaining a valid PUC certificate helps reduce environmental pollution while avoiding traffic penalties.

Vehicle Ownership Transfer

Whenever a vehicle is sold or purchased, ownership must be transferred through the RTO.

Common situations include:

- Sale of used vehicles
- Transfer between family members
- Vehicle inheritance
- Auction purchases

Updating ownership records ensures legal responsibility is correctly assigned.

Hypothecation Services

Vehicles purchased through loans have hypothecation recorded in the Registration Certificate.

After loan repayment, owners can apply for:

- Hypothecation removal
- Addition of hypothecation for new loans
- Modification of finance details

Documents Required at RTO Tiruppur (TN39)
