What Is SIRA?

SIRA stands for the Security Industry Regulatory Agency. It is the government body that regulates all security services and products in Dubai. Every CCTV camera installed in a commercial building, hotel, school, hospital, or government facility must follow SIRA guidelines.

SIRA approval means:

- The camera model is tested and approved
- The installer is licensed and trained
- The system meets minimum quality standards
- Recordings are stored correctly
- Privacy laws are followed

Why SIRA Approval Is Not Optional

Legal Compliance: Operating a CCTV system without SIRA approval is against Dubai law. If authorities inspect your property and find non-compliant cameras, you face penalties.

Insurance Requirements: Many insurance companies require SIRA-approved CCTV as a condition for coverage. If a theft or incident occurs and your cameras are not compliant, your claim may be denied.

Evidence in Legal Cases: Dubai courts only accept footage from approved systems as evidence. If your non-approved cameras capture a crime, the footage may be rejected.
