What Is the Role of RTO Ludhiana?

The Regional Transport Office (RTO) is responsible for implementing motor vehicle and road transport regulations within its jurisdiction. It acts as an important administrative centre for vehicle registration, driving licences, permits, taxation, and other transport-related services. [pb-10](#) is the RTO code associated with Ludhiana in Punjab, identifying vehicles registered under this transport jurisdiction.
