What Is the Difference?

Night vision cameras and traditional security cameras serve the same basic purpose. But they perform very differently in low light.

Traditional cameras – These rely on natural or artificial light to capture images. In bright conditions, they deliver sharp, colorful footage. But as light fades, image quality drops quickly. In near darkness, they produce grainy, unusable footage.

Night vision cameras – These use infrared (IR) technology to see in complete darkness. Built-in IR LEDs emit invisible light that the camera sensor captures, producing clear black-and-white images even in complete darkness.
